## ***Plan #1: The Start-Up Plan***

- It's characterized as A Place to Start:

  - ***Start using the Life Journal***
  - ***Attend LifePath 101***

### **John 1:10-13**

*He came into the very world he created, but the world didn't recognize him. He came to his own people, and even they rejected him. But to all who believed him and accepted him, he gave the right to become children of God. They are reborn—not with a physical birth resulting from human passion or plan, but a birth that comes from God.*

## ***Plan #2: The Friends & Family Plan***

- People who are growing in Christ
- They give their heart to God
- It's characterized as A Heart to Grow:
  - ***Explore serving opportunities***
  - ***Attend LifePath 201***

### **Acts 2:42-47**

*All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer... And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had... They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity—all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.*

### **Ephesians 4:11-13**

*Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ. This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.*

### **Philippians 1:3-6, 9-11**
