Matthew 7:1-4

Do not judge others, and you will not be judged. For you will be treated as you treat others. The standard you use in judging is the standard by which you will be judged. And why worry about a speck in your friend’s eye when you have a log in your own? How can you think of saying to your friend, ‘Let me help you get rid of that speck in your eye,’ when you can’t see past the log in your own eye?

- **Wii love in our B elonging**

1 John 4:6

*But we belong to God, and those who know God listen to us. If they do not **belong** to God, they do not listen to us.*

Romans 12:5

*...so it is with Christ’s body. We are many parts of one body, and we all **belong** to each other.*

- **Wii love in our Caring**

1 John 3:16-18

We know what real love is because Jesus gave up his life for us. So we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters. If someone has enough money to live well and sees a brother or sister in need but shows no compassion—how can God’s love be in that person? Dear children, let’s not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions.

And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need.
